School Family Field Trip - Toledo Mud Hens Education Day

Our school family field trip to the Toledo Mud Hens game is this Wednesday, April 24. We will have our morning chapel service at 8:05 a.m. and then depart for the game. The gates open at 9:30 a.m. and the game begins at 11:05 a.m. There will be educational activities going on around the park prior to the game. Students are asked to wear either their "Grace Given, Grace Driven" school shirts, or if they wish, they can wear Mud Hens gear if they have it. Please note that no food is allowed to be brought in from outside of the park. Also, our seats are behind the Mud Hens dugout, which means we will be in the sunshine for much of the game, so please dress for the weather and make sure your family has hats available, and of course, bring sunscreen!

Field Trip Grades 1-4 - Agriculture Day

On Friday, April 26, the Zion School students in grades 1-4 (and those from grades 5-8 not attending the Ohio School Track Meet) will take a field trip opportunity to learn about farming and agriculture at the Monroe County Fairgrounds on Raisinville Road, sponsored by the MSU Extension and Monroe County 4-H. We will leave the school at 8:30 a.m. to travel to the Monroe County Fairgrounds on Raisinville Road. From 9 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. a tour guide will take our group through a selection of almost forty hands-on activities and demonstrations to inform and spark interest in farming and agriculture topics. Students will need to bring a sack lunch and water. We will have a scheduled time to eat our lunches in the picnic area. Students should dress for the weather and wear comfortable shoes for walking and clothing for being outdoors most of the time. Don't forget a hat, especially if it is sunny! Permission slips for this field trip were due last Friday.

Zion Rummage Sale

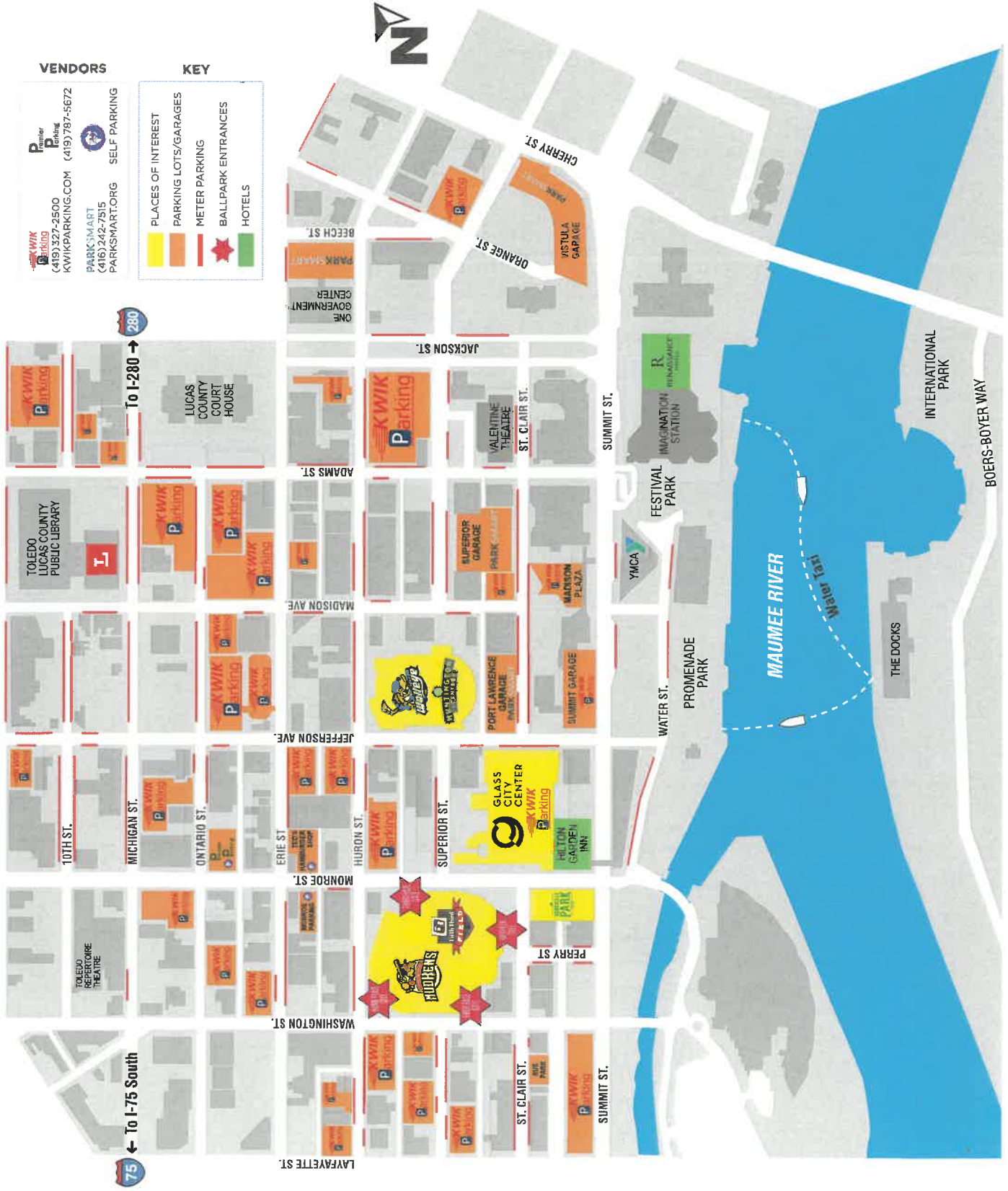

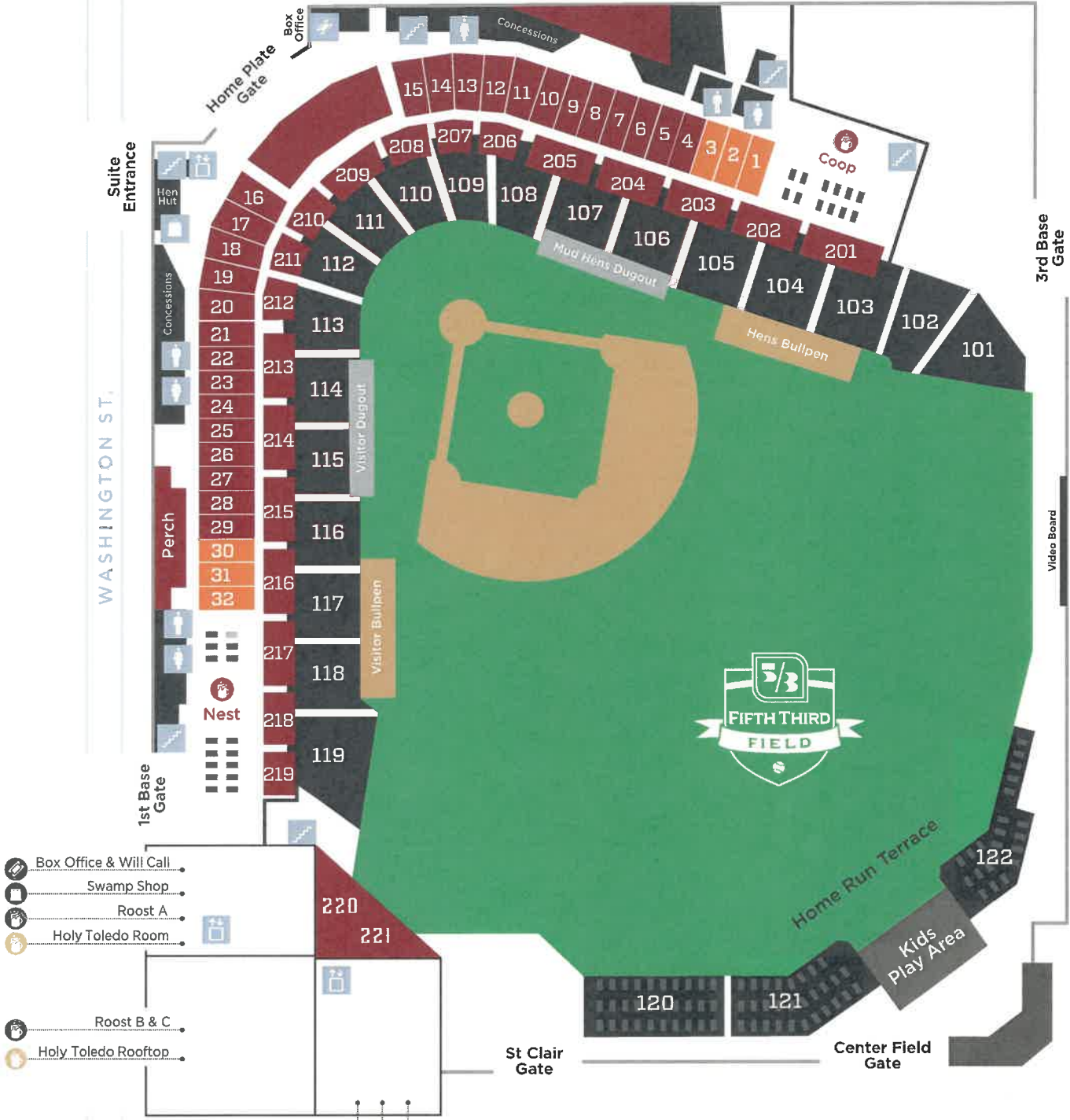

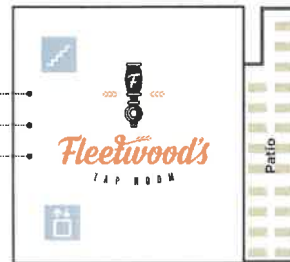
